- 0. Condolence
- 1. To confirm the Minutes of the Seventy-Sixth Annual General Meeting of the Institute held on December 27, 2023 at Heritage Institute of Technology, Kolkata (**Annexure –I**).
- 2. To consider and adopt the Annual Report for 2023-2024 (from 01.04.2023 to 31.03.2024)
- 3. To consider and adopt the Statement of Accounts of the Institute for the year ended on March 31, 2024.
- 4. To take a final decision on the status of RCs (Chennai, Hyderabad, Durgapur, Annamalai Neyvelli, Dehradun, Nagpur, Paradeep, Roorkee, Pondicherry, Goa, Doaba, Haldia ,Kochi, Lucknow, Srinagar, Patna, Rourkela and Sriharikota) in respect of non-receipt of audited Annual Accounts.
- 5. To appoint Auditors for 2023-2024 (IIChE Headquarters Accounts and IIChE Consolidated Accounts) and to fix their remuneration. The term of current auditor M/s MARP & Associates expires on 31.12.2024 and is eligible for reappointment for another two more years. They have offered their willingness to continue as per existing terms & conditions of reappointment.
- 6. To ratify the fees for Fellowship.
- 7. To announce the names of the members elected to the Council for 2025 27 in the vacancies caused by retirement.
- 8. To consider any other business with the permission of the Chair.
- 9. Felicitation of out-going Council Members.

Note: Extract from the Constitution (Rules & Regulations) of the Institute concerning "General Meetings of the Institute" is given below for ready reference:-

# 32. General Meetings of the Institute:

- 32.1 An Annual General Meeting shall as a rule be held within nine months from the end of every financial year. Notice convening the Meeting should be issued to Members at least one month in advance indicating the date, time and venue of the Meeting and the agenda of business to be transacted. The Annual Report of the Institute together with the audited statement of accounts for the preceding financial year shall be presented by the Council and be considered by the Meeting. Resolutions emanating from the Council shall be discussed and voted upon. The Auditor for the next year shall be appointed in the Annual General Meeting and the Auditor's remunerations shall also be fixed. Resolutions submitted by Corporate Members shall then be discussed and voted upon. All resolutions to be moved by Corporate Members must be proposed by one and supported by at least two Corporate Members and must be submitted in writing to the Secretary to reach at least fourteen days before the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 32.2 The President and the Council shall have the powers to accept or reject any such resolution to be moved. After the business on the Agenda is completed, any Corporate Member may move a resolution on any matter of importance and urgency subject to the permission of the Chairman of the Meeting. All resolutions moved at the Annual General Meeting must be seconded before they can be discussed and voted on.
- 32.3 The names of the Members elected to the new Council shall be announced at the Annual General Meeting.
- 32.4 All Corporate Members whose subscriptions have been fully paid by the 31st March of the financial year to which the annual Meeting pertains shall be eligible to vote on matters discussed at the General Meeting.
- 32.5 All the resolutions shall be passed in the Annual General Meeting with simple majority.
- 32.6 Thirty Corporate Members of the Institute shall constitute a quorum for the Annual General Meeting. If there is no quorum, the Meeting shall be adjourned and called after a gap of 15 minutes.

# 1.0 Confirmation of the Minutes of the Seventy-fifth Annual General Meeting of the Institute.

The minutes of the 75<sup>th</sup> (Seventy-fifth) Annual General Meeting, held on 28.12.2021 at HBTU, Kanpur were confirmed, as proposed by Mr. Dhawal Saxena and seconded by Prof. C. Karthikeyan except reference no. 5 i.e., Issue regarding maintenance charges by Calcutta Regional Centre where the AGM unanimously decided that Calcutta Regional Centre should pay for:

- (i) The maintenance charges for the room of HQ building which houses CRC Office on a pro-rata basis w.r.t. HQ Building.
- (ii) The consumption of electricity power based on the actual meter reading.
- (iii) availing of other facilities of the building viz. use of the auditorium, seminar room (as and when used) as per the prevailing rate of Jadavpur University

The members of the EC at Calcutta Regional Centre requested that the issue be deliberated with CRC members prior to implementation.

**Note:** The Building Committee in its 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 08.06.2019 recommended to request Calcutta RC to contribute a sum of Rs.10,000/- per month to IIChE-HQ towards compensating the expenditure towards Maintenance Charge & Electricity Bill. The same was approved in the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council for 2019 dated 20.07.2019 at Trivandrum. In context of that, Council in its 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting 2022 held on 26.02.2022 opined that the President will write a letter to the Calcutta Regional Centre for contributing some amount to HQ towards maintenance charge & electricity bill. As per decision of the Council in the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 26.02.2022, a letter duly signed by the President & Honorary Secretary, has been sent on June 06, 2022, to

the Chairman and Honorary Secretary of Calcutta Regional Centre, requesting them to contribute the amount on pro-rata basis for:

- i) Maintenance charge
- ii) Consumption of electricity based on electrical meter reading
- iii) Availing of facilities like Auditorium, Seminar Hall as per the subsidized rate of Jadavpur University.

Moreover, Council authorized President to send a letter to CRC with reference to the point of (iii) with immediate effect. However, no decision / response is received from the Chairman / Honorary Secretary of the CRC. Council, unanimously authorized President in its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting on 26.08.2022 to send a final letter to CRC for payment of maintenance charges, failing of CRC council will take appropriate decision.

# 2.0 Consideration and Adoption of the Annual Report for 2022-2023 (from 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023) and Adoption of the Audited Statement of Accounts of the Institute for the year ended 31.3.2022.

The Honorary Secretary provided a comprehensive overview of the activity reports from the Headquarters, Regional Centres, and Student Chapters for the year 2023 to the members. Additionally, he outlined the key highlights from Council Meetings and Sub-committee Meetings held throughout the year.

Furthermore, the Honorary Secretary presented details from the Audited Accounts, covering aspects such as Total Income, Total Expenditures, Net Surplus, and Net Profit Ratio for both Consolidated and IIChE Headquarters accounts.

Emphasizing the importance of timely reporting, the Honorary Secretary urged all Regional Centers to submit their annual reports, including audited financial reports, within the designated timeframe set by the Headquarters.

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) unanimously approved the Annual Report and the Audited Statement of Accounts of IIChE, as proposed by Prof. Sudip Kumar Das and seconded by Dr. S. Bajpai.

# 3.0 Decision on action in respect of non-receipt of audited accounts from RCs (Annamalai, Durgapur, Dehradun, Nagpur, Paradeep, Roorkee, Srinagar and Sriharikota)

The members opined that the incoming Council and the Vice-President incharge - Regional Centers' Affairs shall look into the matter and take necessary steps to receive the annual accounts from those Regional Centers at the earliest.

### 4.0 Appointment of Auditors for 2023-24 and fixation of their remuneration

The AGM passed the resolution of appointment of M/s MARP & ASSOCIATES, Chartered Accountants, 20B, Abdul Hamid Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room No. – 15, Kolkata – 700 069 as Auditors of the Institute for the financial year 2023-2024 for the IIChE Headquarters Accounts and the IIChE Consolidated Accounts as well as All Taxation related matters with the following remuneration:

# 5.0 Ratification of the decision of the Council

The Honorary Secretary reported that as per the recommendations of the Council, Clause No 16.3 i.e., Additional fee payable for transfer from one category of Membership to the next higher category shall be the difference between the admission fees of the two categories as given in Appendix Table-1 (a) will no longer be applicable for Life Fellowship Application. The revised fees and subscription for Life Fellows will be as follows:
